Jet Trax ATV/Snowmobile Installation Instructions

These instructions are to insure proper installation of your ATV/Snowmobile decks, which will enhance the safety and reliability of your Jet Trax system. The Jet Trax System is designed to provide years of dependable service without undue maintenance cost or operations problems. By following these step-by-step instructions, your Jet Trax System will become a secure and reliable transporting and loading device.

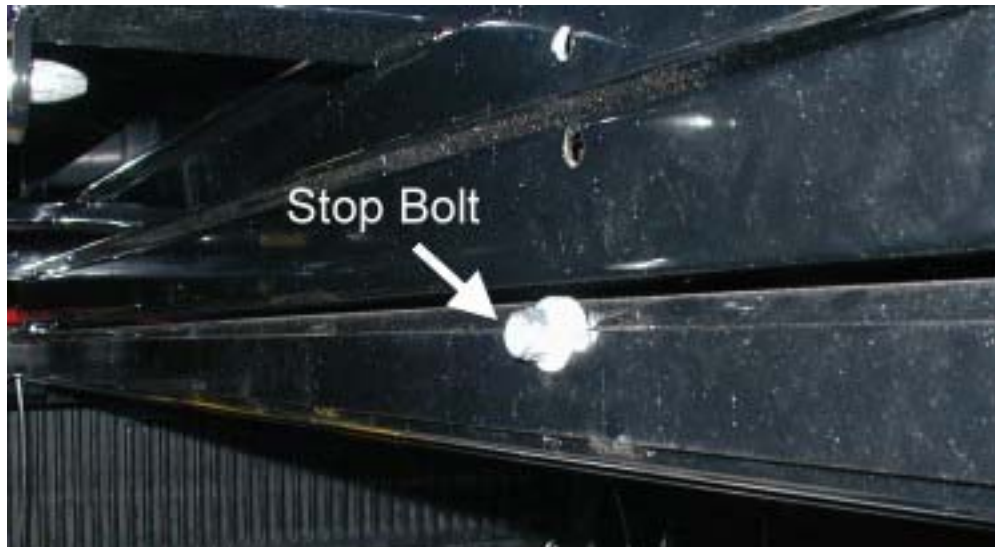
STEP 1

Read these instructions completely before starting the installation. Pay particular attention to all of the safety notes.

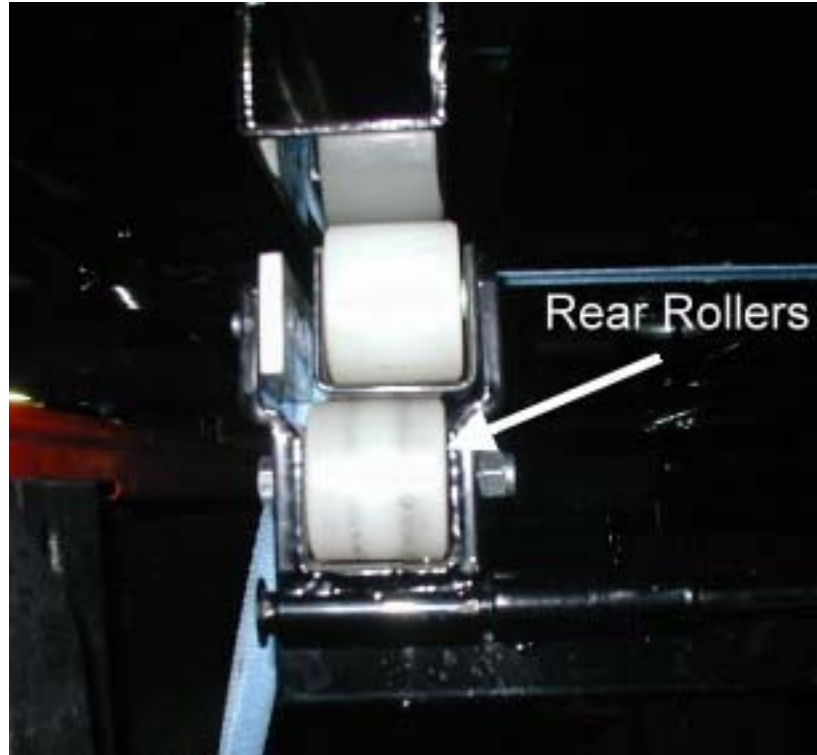
STEP 2

Removing the Watercraft Deck

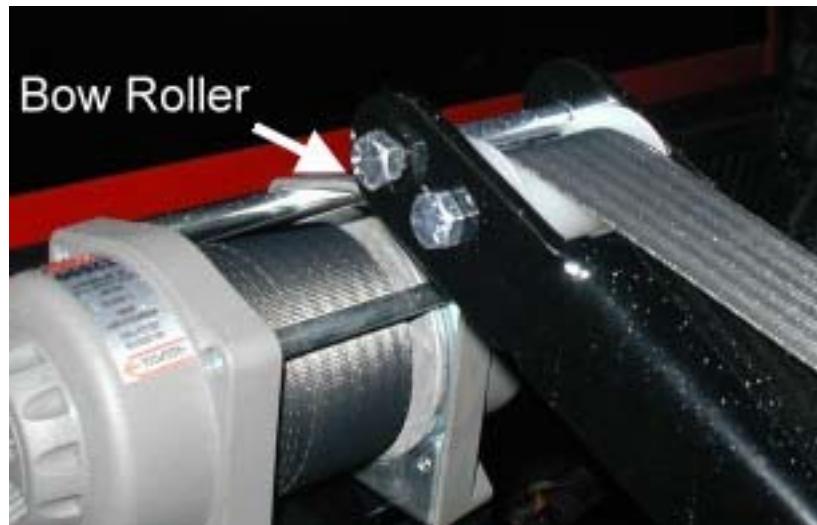
1. Remove the 2 3/8 inch Stop bolts located 13 1/2" from the rear of the Jet Trax unit.



2. Remove the 2 white rear rollers



3. Remove the Bow Strap Bolt in front of the roller



4. Remove the winch strap from the cradle
5. Slide watercraft cradle off of base unit

STEP 3

Installing the ATV/Snowmobile Deck

1. Insert 1 ft of chain (included in kit) to lengthen the cables located at the front of the rack
2. Slide ATV/Snowmobile deck into slotted rails on the base unit.
3. Re-install the 2 white rear rollers
4. Re-install the 1 stop bolt on the outer rail of both decks
5. On the inside stop bolts, (on both decks) replace the stop bolt with a new 3/8 inch X 3 inch stop bolt using the 3 washers as spacers



6. Install the black safety bracket. Use the safety travel pin with this bracket to lock all rails together while traveling.



7. Install winch strap over bow strap roller
8. Re-install bolt at top



9. Loosen the 4 winch bolts located under the winch
10. Slide the winch to align the winch with the ATV/Snowmobile decks.

11. Re-tighten winch bolts
12. Insert Travel pin (Included in kit) through the new black safety bracket and through the metal slot rail.
13. The unit is now safe for traveling.

Steps to insure safe and proper operation of your Jet Trax System

System Checkout

1. Check to make sure that your Jet Trax system is securely fastened onto your vehicle with the mounting plate, bolts and hardware
2. Check the battery to see that it is fully charged and ready for use.
3. Check the safety transport pin, at the rear of the transport unit. The transport safety pin should be in place at **ALL TIMES**. The only exception would be during loading and unloading.
4. Check to make sure that your ATV or Snowmobile is secured using a nylon strap from the back of the ATV or Snowmobile to the bumper of the truck.

NEVER ALLOW anyone in the back of the vehicle while the loading or unloading operation is in progress. **PERSONAL INJSURY MAY RESULT!!**

Jet Trax Transport System Users Guide

To Load your ATV or Snowmobile

1. Lower your truck tail gate
2. Check operation of the Jet Trax System by turning the Winch Remote Control Switch to the OUT (up) position and then to the IN (down position momentarily.
3. Remove the Travel Pin
4. Hold on to the deck and pull on the ATV/Snowmobile deck while pressing the winch Remote Control Switch to the OUT position. This will start extending the deck all of the way to the ground. Hold the Remote Control Switch in the OUT position until the deck is fully extended and touching the ground.
5. Align ATV/Snowmobile to deck keeping the inside wheels as close to the center of the truck as possible
6. Take the tow hook, at the end of the winch strap, and hook it securely to the tow eyelet or bumper of your ATV or Snowmobile.

WARNING: Make sure the winch strap is STRAIGHT and NOT TWISTED, to insure proper operation.

7. Push the Remote Control Switch to the IN position. This will start the Jet Trax system pulling your ATV or Snowmobile on to the Jet Trax deck. Hold the Remote Control Switch in the IN position until your ATV or Snowmobile is pulled completely onto the vehicle.
8. Insert the Transport Safety Pin after the system is pulled onto the vehicle.
9. Attach the Transport Safety Chain to the tow eyelet on the front of the ATV or Snowmobile.
10. Secure the rear of the ATV or Snowmobile using a ratcheted tie down strap from the back of the ATV or Snowmobile to the bumper.

To Unload your ATV or Snowmobile

1. Lower your truck tail gate
2. Check operation of the Jet Trax System by turning the Winch Remote Control Switch to the OUT (up) position and then to the IN (down position momentarily.
3. Remove the Travel Pin
4. Hold on to the deck and pull on the ATV/Snowmobile deck while pressing the winch Remote Control Switch to the OUT position. This will start extending the deck all of the way to the ground. Hold the Remote Control Switch in the OUT position until the deck is fully extended and touching the ground.

WARNING: Make sure the winch strap is securely attached to the ATV or Snowmobile at all times during loading and unloading. If the Winch strap is not securely attached, damage to the ATV or Snowmobile and/or personal injury may result.

5. Un hook the ATV/Snowmobile from the winch tow hook
6. Hook the winch strap to the Jet Trax bunk.
7. Push the Remote Control Switch to the IN position. This will start the Jet Trax system pulling your ATV or Snowmobile on to the Jet Trax deck. Hold the Remote Control Switch in the IN position until your ATV or Snowmobile is pulled completely onto the vehicle.
8. Insert the Transport Safety Pin after the system is pulled onto the vehicle.

Following these directions, steps and warnings will help insure safety and enjoyment while using your ATV or Snowmobile and the Jet Trax Transport System.
